NCGopher is a simple gopher client for DOS, made for the sole purpose of having a client with decent speed that runs on an 8088. It depends heavily on mTCP's netcat utility. To be very precise, here is what you need to use NCGopher: ## System Requirements ## \* 8088 or 80x86 based machine with 640kb of RAM (less?) \* DOS (only tested on 6.22, but older versions should work) \* Ethernet card, installed and configured \* Working and running packet driver for ethernet \* mTCP from Michael Brutman, <https://www.brutman.com/mTCP/> \* mTCP configuration to match your network, nc.exe working
